

First Firing Instructions - Refractory Cement Crucibles

Prior to the first debinding and sintering cycles with your new crucible, it is recommended to fire the crucible in a kiln with the instructions below:

- 1. Place the lid on the (empty) crucible.
- 2. Place the crucible in the kiln.
- 3. Ramp to 649°C (1200°F) over 4 hours
- 4. Hold for 1 hour.
- 5. Program ends cooldown.

When unpacking there will be some surface pitting but after fire this should smooth out and won't affect future use.

Not performing the first firing can result in the crucible cracking during sintering.
